The University of The Bahamas (UB) held its Northern Bahamas Campus Charter Celebration Ceremony on Thursday, April 27 at the Northern Campus with much pomp and pageantry.

The ceremony, which started at 10:00 a.m. featured remarks from UB Dr. Earl Cash, Chairman of the Board of Trustees; Sarah St. George, Vice Chairman of the Grand Bahama Port Authority (GBPA); Dr. Rodney D. Smith, UB President and Minister for Grand Bahama, Dr. Michael Darville.

Dr. Coralee Kelly, Vice President (Interim) of the Northern Bahamas Campus stated that UB has come a long way, but there is still much to be done.

"There is a lot of work that needs to be done while we are aware that there are many challenges, we are very mindful that there are many possibilities," she said.

Speaking of the campus' expansion, Sarah St. George noted how many students would now have the opportunity to study in Grand Bahama, as opposed

CHANCES GAMES IS NOT CLOSING ITS DOORS

Raymond R.H. Culmer, CEO of Jarol Investments Ltd. and Chances Games, in an interview with *this daily* on Wednesday, April 26, dispelled recent rumors that Chances Games would be shutting down.

"Shutting down is not shutting down," declared Culmer. "Staff and customers can be assured that we are here to stay."

He added that Chances does have an ongoing court case and is seeking a determination from the courts on whether the Grand Bahama Port Authority (GBPA) would give them a gaming license and tax them on a level comparable to the Gaming Board and the Government of The Bahamas.

Culmer stated that Chances would abide by the outcome of the court proceedings.

"We have been all in from the time the legalization of this industry has began," he said.
