**Grayson County Health Department**

The Grayson County Health Department offers numerous services. Sherman and Denison regular office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Offices are located at 515 N. Walnut in Sherman (903) 893-0131 and 205 N. Houston Ave. in Denison (903) 465-2878.

Immunizations are offered 1 to 6 p.m. Wednesday and Thursdays in Sherman and Tuesdays from 1 to 6 p.m. in Denison.

**WIC Supplemental Food Program**

Nutrition education and food vouchers for pregnant and breastfeeding women and for infants and children under age 5, according to financial and nutritional needs. WIC is open 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Thursday, but it's closed on first working day of each month from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the third Thursday of each month.

**Family Planning Clinic**

Annual women's health checkups, including Pap smears to prevent cervical cancer and breast exams to detect breast cancer early;

birth control, including pills, shots and sterilizations including vasectomy; pre-conceptional counseling for women planning a pregnancy. It is for women financially eligible in Grayson County. Call the Sherman office to make an appointment. Testing for sexually transmitted diseases is on Thursday at 1 p.m. To be seen, come to the Sherman office between 1 and 1:30 p.m.

**GEMS Clinic**

Women who are 45 to 64 years old and qualify financially are eligible to receive pap tests, breast exams and hospital mammograms, and screening for high blood pressure, diabetes, and high cholesterol. Call the Sherman office to make an appointment.

**Other Services**

Other services available in the Sherman office include immunizations (including vaccines needed for foreign travel), blood pressure screening and monitoring, and pregnancy tests and



counseling. There are also tests for AIDS and tuberculosis, which include treatment and counseling. Routine immunizations and tests for tuberculosis are available in the

Denison office as well.

**Health Education & Wellness**

Outreach health services including programs, literature, educational materials, films and speakers. It also includes the Wellness Clinics, which can be sponsored by and held at any business, school or industry to provide confidential medical testing and current information. Call the Denison office.

**Indigent Health Care**

Inpatient and outpatient health care services are available to the poorest residents of Grayson County when no other system is available. Grayson County Indigent Health

Care is aimed at providing emergency and short-term health care services for adult residents of Grayson County whose income is in the lowest poverty standards established by the federal government. Call the Denison office.

**Animal Control**

Enforcement of animal control and rabies control laws and regulations outside city limits of Sherman, Denison, and Whitesboro. Call the Denison office.

**Environmental Health**

Inspections of food service establishments including restaurants, bars, schools, and vendors at festivals and fairs; day care centers; public and semi-public swimming pools. Investigation of environmental complaints. Training of food service workers and issues operational permits. Call the Denison office. Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

**Greater Texoma Utility Authority**

The Greater Texoma Utility Authority is a local political subdivision of the state and is governed by a Board of Directors, which is responsible for all of the business of the Authority.

The Authority provides its member cities with assistance in financing and construction of water and wastewater facilities. The Authority may also be requested to provide operations services for water and wastewater facilities by member cities and others.

While the state legislature may have enacted a law to authorize the Authority, the cities of Denison and Sherman actually created the district by a confirmation election held August 19, 1979. Since that time, the Cities of Bailey, Collinsville, Gainesville, Gunter, Howe, Leonard, Muenster, Pottsboro, Tioga, Tom Bean, Valley View, Van Alstyne, Whitesboro and Whitewright have also joined as member cities of the Authority.
