You are hereby notified that on December 28, 2007, the will of the above-named decedent dated August 23, 1979, was admitted to probate in the above-captioned proceedings and Lori A. Heller was appointed as Administratrix c.t.a. of such will, without bond.

You are further advised that under the provisions of the Kansas Simplified Estates Act, the Court need not supervise administration of the estate and no further notice of any action of the Administratrix c.t.a. or other proceedings of the administration will be given, except for notice of petition to sell, lease or mortgage real property and notice of final settlement of the decedent's estate. You are further advised that if written objections to simplified administration are filed with the Court, the Court may order that supervised administration ensue.

All creditors are notified to exhibit their demands against the estate within four (4) months from the date of the first publication of this notice as provided by law, and if their demands are not thus exhibited, they shall be forever barred.
